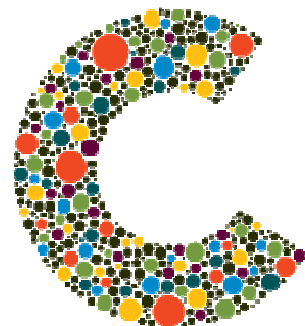
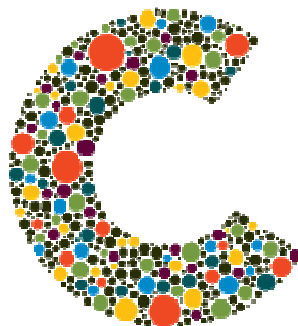
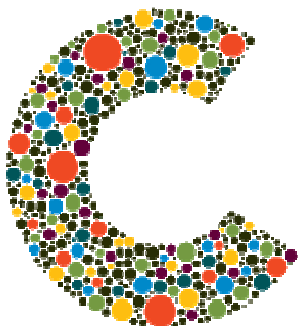

CHILDREN'S THEATRE FESTIVAL

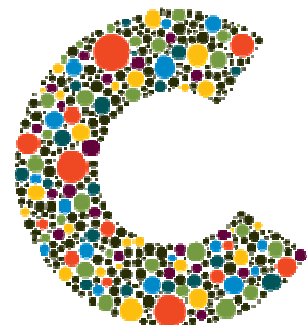
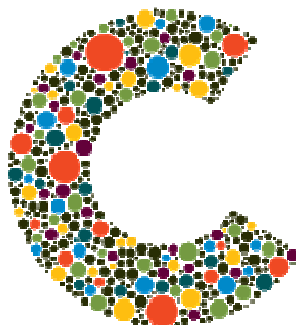
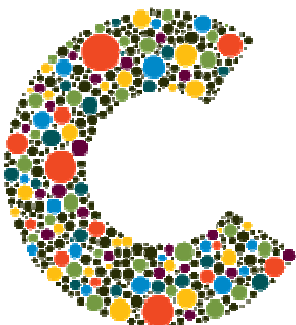
