Reminder about School Uniform

We would like to remind all families that we have a uniform policy at Cavendish. We deliberately keep our policy simple and as affordable as possible, but we stipulate that the children must stick to our school colours as follows: white shirts, red jumpers/sweatshirts/cardigans, grey trousers/pinafores/skirts, sensible footwear. Unlike many schools, we don't insist that clothing should have logos or any fancy embellishment/piping and we don't insist that you purchase it from a specific outlet – we want to keep costs down. Please work with us on this and ensure that your child keeps to our straightforward uniform rules unless it is a designated non-uniform day. If your daughter wears a skirt to school, please make sure she is comfortable with its length. We have noticed some of the Y5 and Y6 girls fiddling with their skirts and trying to pull them down a little, and they say it's because they feel self-conscious about the short length. Children grow so quickly, and therefore grow out of clothes too! We want the children to be able to run and play and climb at breaktimes without any worries about their clothing.

New Holiday Care Club

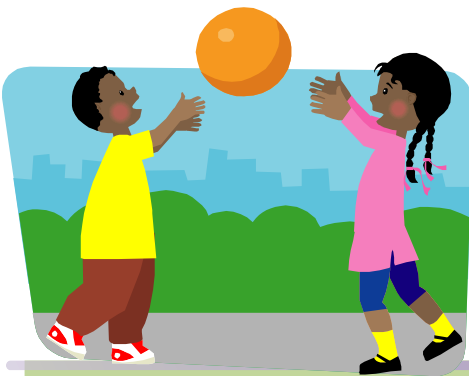
