### SAFETY ISSUE

We have noticed that some children are arriving at school very early in the mornings.

**We'd like to advise you that no child should be left at school before 8.30am unless they are attending a supervised activity such as Before School Club, Breakfast Club (from 8.15am) etc.** It is dark, cold and often wet

out there at present and the children should not be left to their own devices. It is also a safety risk for them as the school gates are open at that time.

Unfortunately, Glynis has also told me that some older children have not behaved appropriately at our Breakfast Club. Any child who continues to misbehave will simply not be allowed to attend the club, so please have a chat to your child if they currently have breakfast at school in our dining room, and make sure that they understand this.
