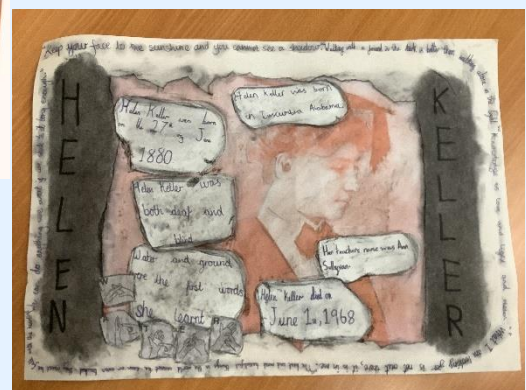
## The BIG Unveiling!
