We wish Mrs Mitchell all the best as she begins her maternity leave. Lots of love to her and the family xxx

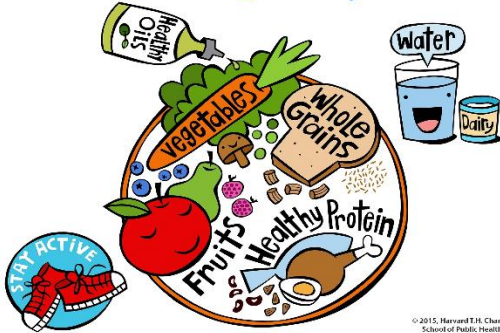

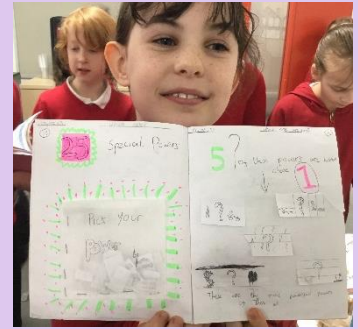
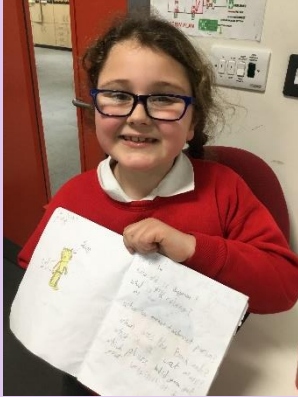
