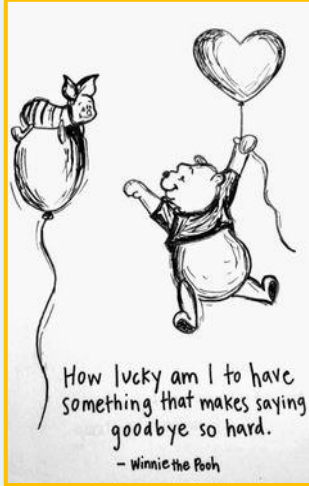

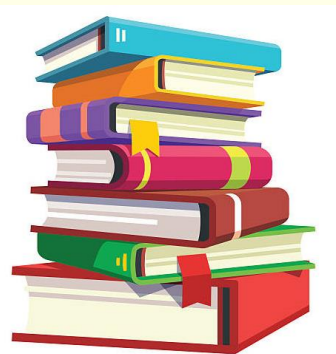

They were extremely impressed with our BRILLIANT Rights Respecting Councillors, staff and parents.

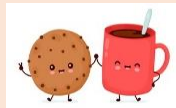
Many thanks to the parents and carers who took time out to speak to the verifier.
