

We are a Rights Respecting School and follow the UNICEF Children's Rights. Rights Respecting Councillors represent each class.

Good To Be Green: Great To Be Golden

All children start on green but everyone aims to be GOLDEN!

If you are not safe, or don't show respect or kindness, adults will give you a

- STOP & THINK to remind you
- Yellow Card to show you that you need to make a better choice
- Red Card which means you will have Reflection Time to think about how you have gone wrong with your behaviour and how to put it right and improve.

<u>Extra help -</u> We are all different and sometimes children need extra help or things done in a different way.

Good to be GREEN steps	
STOP 'n' Think!	The adult has had to remind you of our values. What is the right choice? STOP & THINK!
Yellow Card Warning Card	You have not changed your behaviour. Make the right choice. STOP & THINK!
Red Card R's Good to be Green! B RED CARD	You need to make a change in your behaviour. You are not being the best you. STOP, THINK & CHANGE!
Reflection Time	STAY CALM. REFLECT on what went wrong. Use the Reflection sheet to help.
Talk	How can you put it right and be the best you?

We are an ANTI-Bullying school

We don't accept bullying at Cavendish. You always have someone to talk to. The trusted adults in school will help you. It's not right to be unkind back. We all agree to not ignore bullying if we see it.

We use our KINDNESS COMMITMENT to remind everyone that kindness is important and hate is not wanted.

The adults in school will...

- Be fair & listen with respect
- Help you if you need it
- Give you advice
- Remind you how to behave using the golden values
- Give you time to reflect on what you did wrong
- Give you a brain break if you need one
- Use 'Stop & Think', Yellow & Red cards to help you make good behaviour choices
- Help you to be a BRILLIANT citizen
