Thank you to our wonderful lunchtime staff. Children prepared food, set up for lunch and helped clean up.



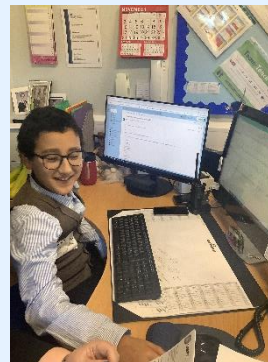


Take Over Day

It's been a pleasure being your colleague, I'm sure our paths will cross in the future. Feel free to get in touch if you ever need to bounce any ideas off me.

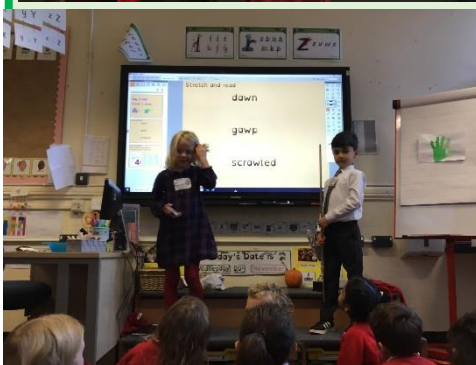
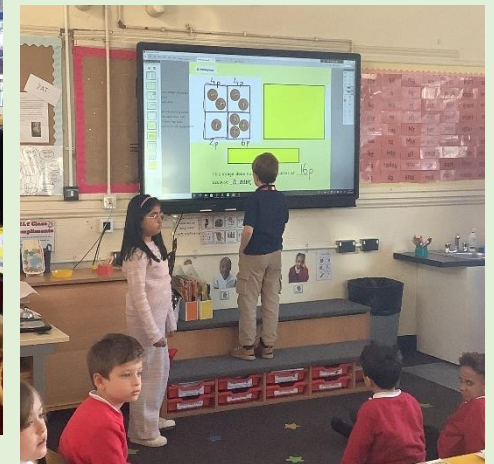
