They wondered how so much litter had ended up on our field. We talked about litter being dropped and blown in.

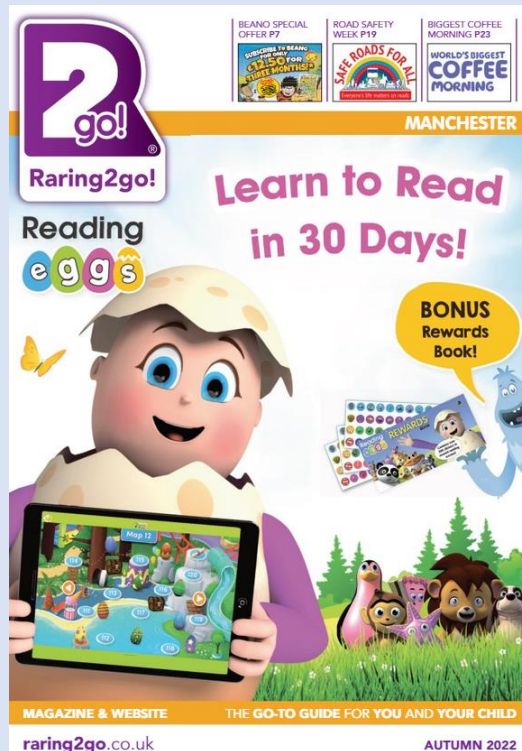
They said the litter 'feels like it's never ending... Like infinity!!'
